* Definition of Children and Vulnerable Adult

Children: A child is defined as a person under the age of 18 (The Children Law 2008)

Vulnerable adults: A person aged 18 or over who receives services of a type listed in paragraph (1) below, and in consequence of a condition of a type listed in paragraph (2) below, has a disability of a type listed at (3) below.

1. The services are:
 - Accommodation and nursing or personal care in a care home
 - Personal care or support to live independently in his or her own home
 - Any service provided by an independent hospital, independent clinic, independent medical agency or National Health Service body
 - Social care services; **or**
 - Any services provided in an establishment catering for a person with learning difficulties

2. The conditions are:
 - A learning or physical disability
 - A physical or mental illness, chronic or otherwise, including an addiction to alcohol or drugs; **or**
 - A reduction in physical or mental capacity

3. The disabilities are:
 - A dependency on others in the performance of, or a requirement for assistance in the performance of, basic physical functions
 - Severe impairment in the ability to communicate with others; **or**
 - Impairment in a person’s ability to protect him or herself from assault, abuse or neglect

Sport and physical activity can and does play a major role in promoting inclusion of all groups in society. However, inequalities have traditionally existed particularly in relation to gender, race and disability. Cobo Air Rifle Club is committed to promoting and developing sports equity, which is about fairness in sport, equality of access, recognising inequalities and taking steps to address them. By monitoring the profile of young people in clubs, we can identify any issues relating to under-representation of different groups and can together develop strategies to ensure all young people have an opportunity in the future development and progress in sport and physical activity.
